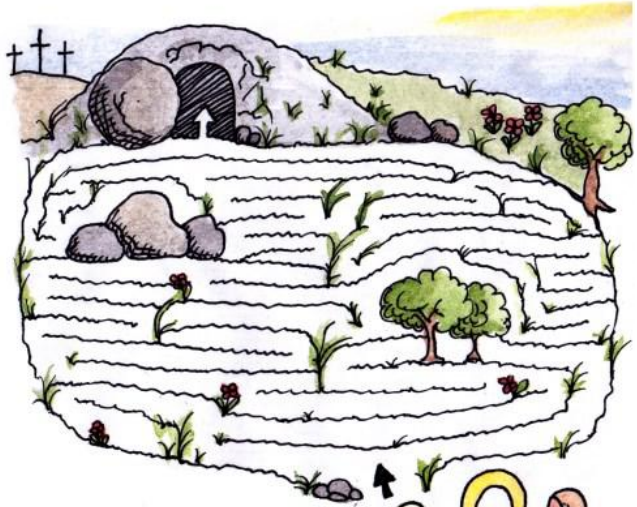

Easter Morning

From the Gospel of John

ON THE THIRD DAY AFTER JESUS DIED, MARY MAGDALENE WENT TO THE TOMB VERY EARLY IN THE MORNING WHILE IT WAS STILL DARK.



BUT FINDING THE STONE ROLLED AWAY, SHE RAN TO FIND PETER AND JOHN.



SHE TOLD THEM WHAT SHE HAD SEEN.



PETER AND JOHN RAN TO THE TOMB TO SEE.

JOHN RAN FASTER AND GOT THERE BEFORE PETER. HE LOOKED IN THE TOMB.



WHEN PETER GOT THERE HE WENT INSIDE THE TOMB.



THEY SAW THE CLOTHS LYING THERE, AND THE PIECE OF CLOTH THAT HAD BEEN ON HIS HEAD WAS FOLDED AND SET IN A DIFFERENT PLACE.

THE DISCIPLES WERE VERY SAD AND AFRAID AFTER JESUS DIED ON THE CROSS. ON THE SUNDAY MORNING MARY MAGDALENE WENT TO SEE AND HONOUR THE BODY OF JESUS, BUT HE WAS GONE! LATER IN THE DAY JESUS APPEARED TO THE WOMEN AND THEN TO THE APOSTLES. CAN YOU IMAGINE THEIR JOY?

Alleluia!



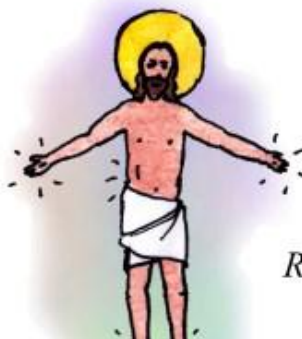
Easter is the time when we celebrate Jesus' rising from the dead.

Imagine the joy of Our Lady that her Son was alive again! Here is a special Easter prayer to Our Lady:

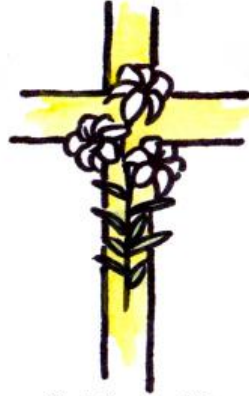


*Queen of Heaven, rejoice! Alleluia!
