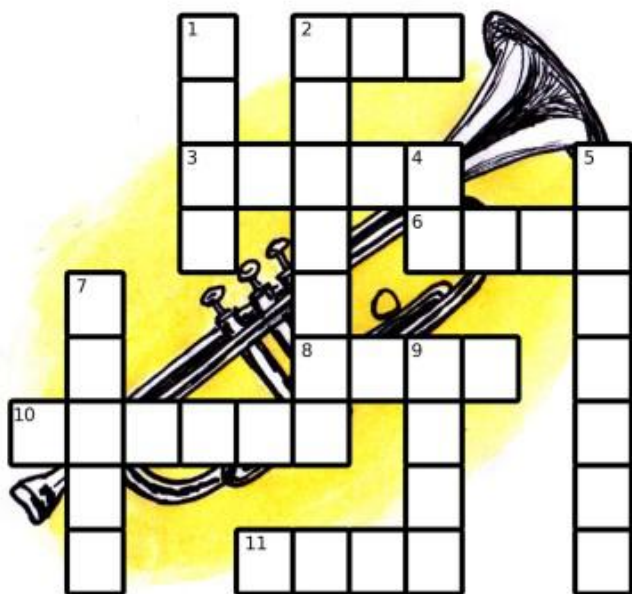

Sing SIEARP (10A) to our INKG (11A), sing praise.

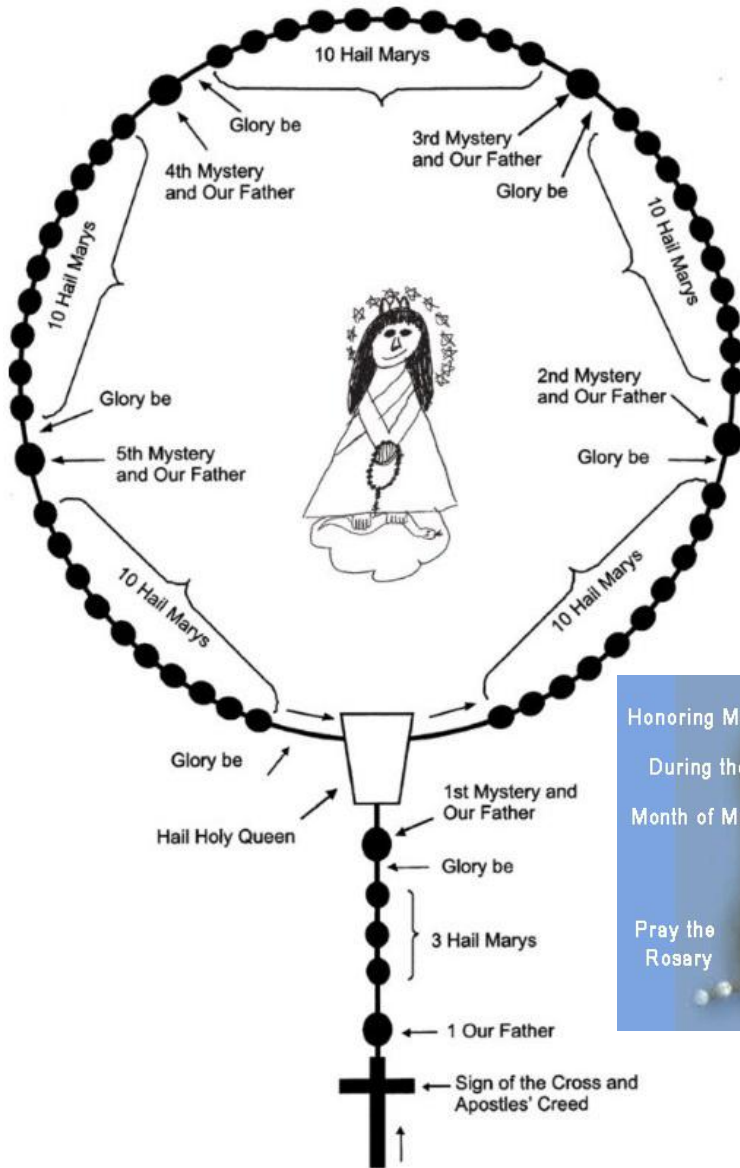
