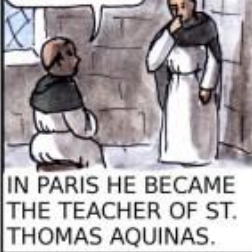

HE WAS MADE BISHOP OF REGENSBURG AND TOOK PART IN THE COUNCIL OF LYONS.



FOR 20 YEARS ALBERT WROTE A COLLECTION OF ALL THE SCIENTIFIC KNOWLEDGE OF HIS TIME.

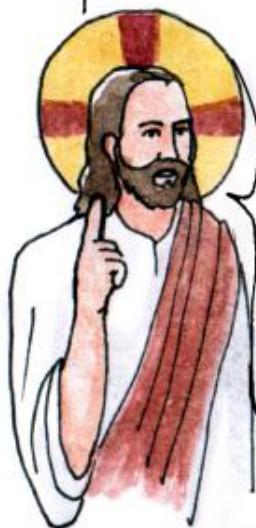


Thomas' arguments are logical. They must be defended in the universities.



ST. ALBERT WENT BACK TO PARIS TO DEFEND THE STUDIES OF ST. THOMAS, HIS STUDENT. HE DIED IN 1280, BUT WAS ONLY CANONIZED IN 1931.

SAINT ALBERT STUDIED ALL THE KNOWLEDGE OF HIS TIME SO THAT HE COULD BETTER UNDERSTAND GOD. HE SAW EVERYTHING IN SCIENCE AS A PROOF OF GOD'S WORK. SOMETIMES PEOPLE SAY THAT RELIGION IS AGAINST SCIENCE, BUT WE CAN LEARN FROM ST. ALBERT TO SEE GOD'S HAND IN ALL CREATION.

2. Touch the center of your chest and pray, "and of The Son."



3. Touch your left shoulder and pray, "and of The Holy..."



4. Touch your right shoulder and pray, "Spirit, Amen."
