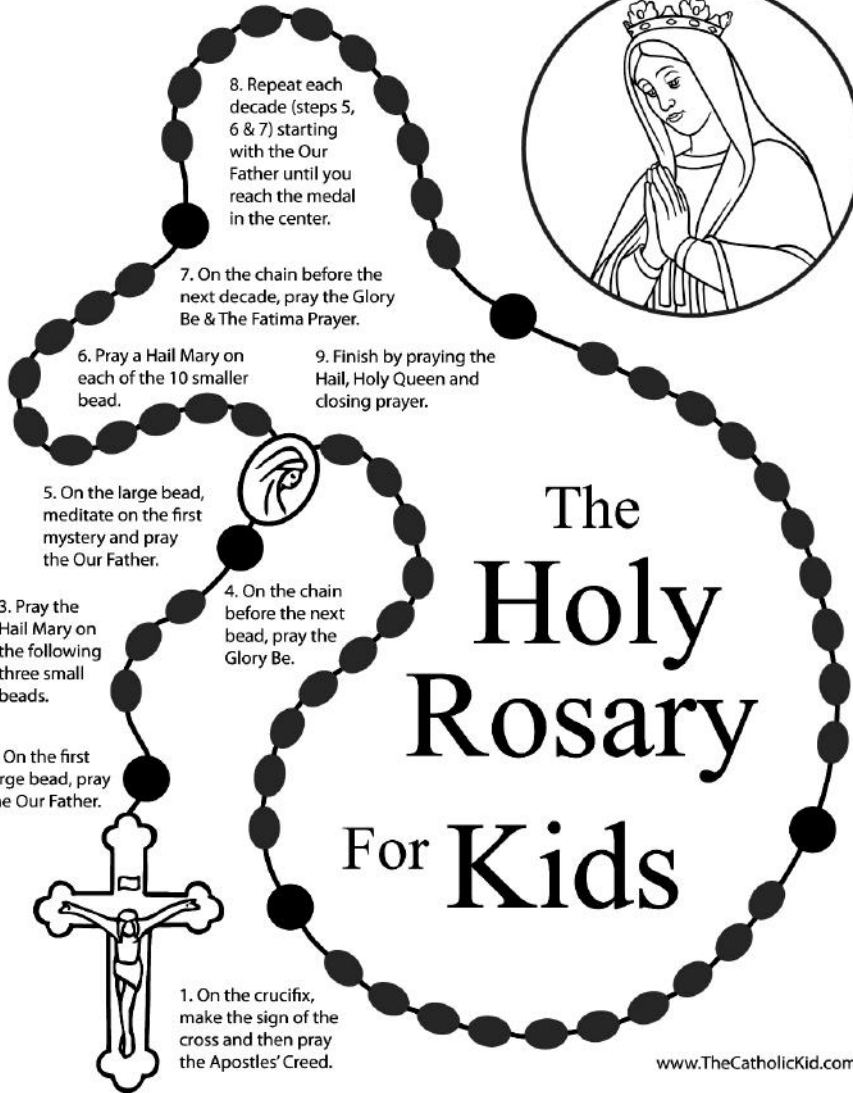

9. Finish by praying the Hail, Holy Queen and closing prayer.

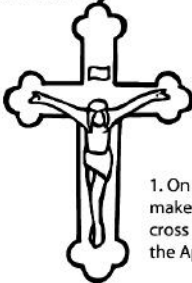
5. On the large bead, meditate on the first mystery and pray the Our Father.
