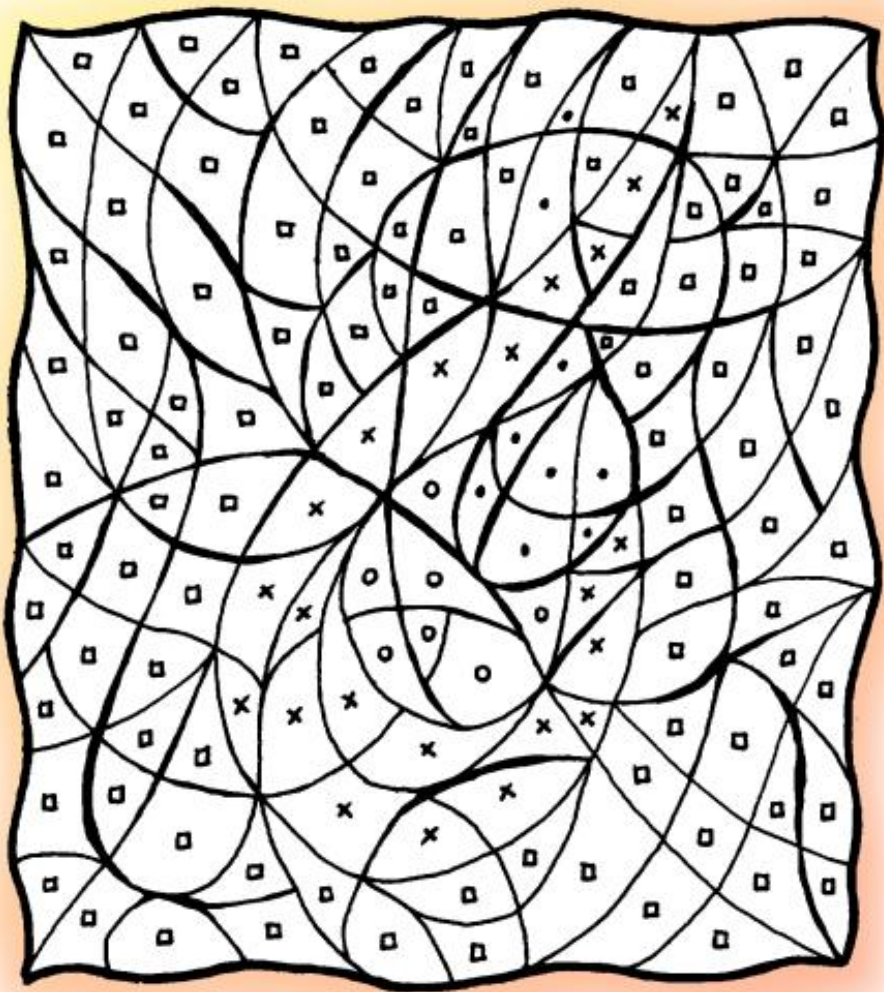

4. Touch your right shoulder and pray, "Spirit, Amen."
